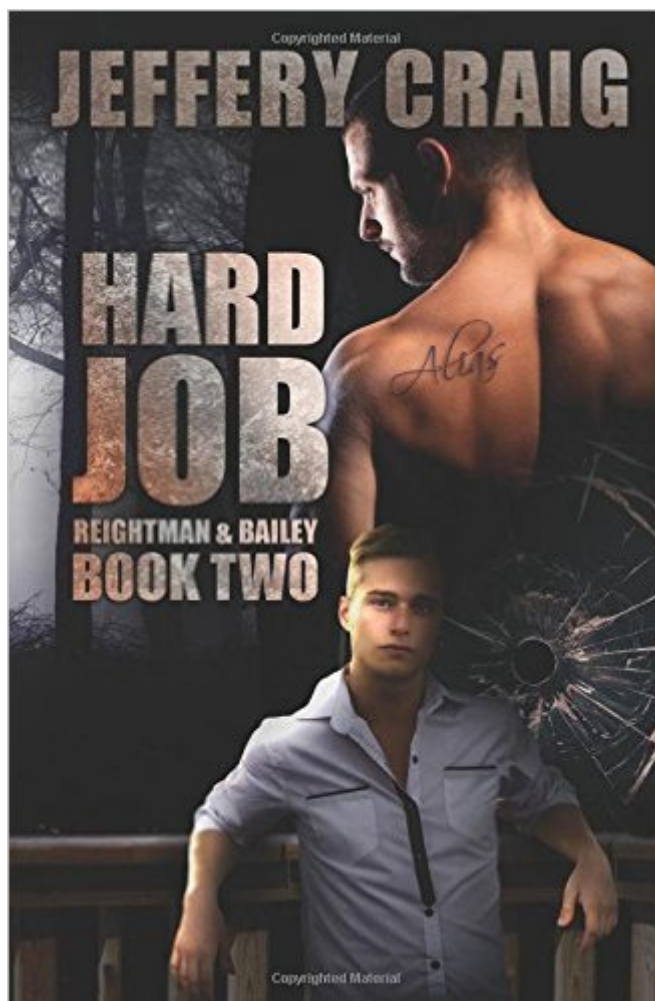

This one is the second book in the Reightman & Bailey series, and it literally picks up on a "next page" basis from the cliffhanger ending of book one. I'm actually glad that the author chose to do them as two books, even though the story continues directly into this second half. Some of you might not be up to 680 pages in one sitting, but trust me, I was.
