

Daunted by the prospect of catching up with a fifty-year franchise, many potential Star Trek fans just gave up until Director J.J. Abrams™ introduced the phenomenon to a brand-new audience in

2009. Serving as the perfect gateway to Gene Roddenberry's iconic show, the film generated interest in new fans who still had work to do to catch up and understand what has come before. All that has changed with DK's The Star Trek Book, a perfect guide to Star Trek and its history. Explaining the book as useful to only new or casual fans would be selling it short however, as authors Paul Ruditis and Sandford Galden-Stone provide an excellent and quick resource to longtime fans as well. The Star Trek Book takes readers on a written journey of "Where No One Has Gone Before", explaining the course of Gene Roddenberry's idea from its first-unaired pilot episode in 1964, its cinematic rebirth in 1979 with the release of Star Trek The Motion Picture to the success of its four spin-offs and subsequent feature films. While the book does not provide any new tidbits for longtime fans, Ruditis and Galden-Stone do look at the scientific and technological impact Star Trek has had, as well as explain certain ideas like how fast is Warp Speed (even the most dedicated fans would be hard pressed to know that impulse speed is 270 million kilometers per hour). Each ship and its crew get a two-page historical summary that also includes the new Kelvin Timeline, as the J.J. Abrams' films are referred to in the book. In fact, all sorts of timelines are diagrammed to give fans an understanding of where certain events fall into the five-decade lore.
