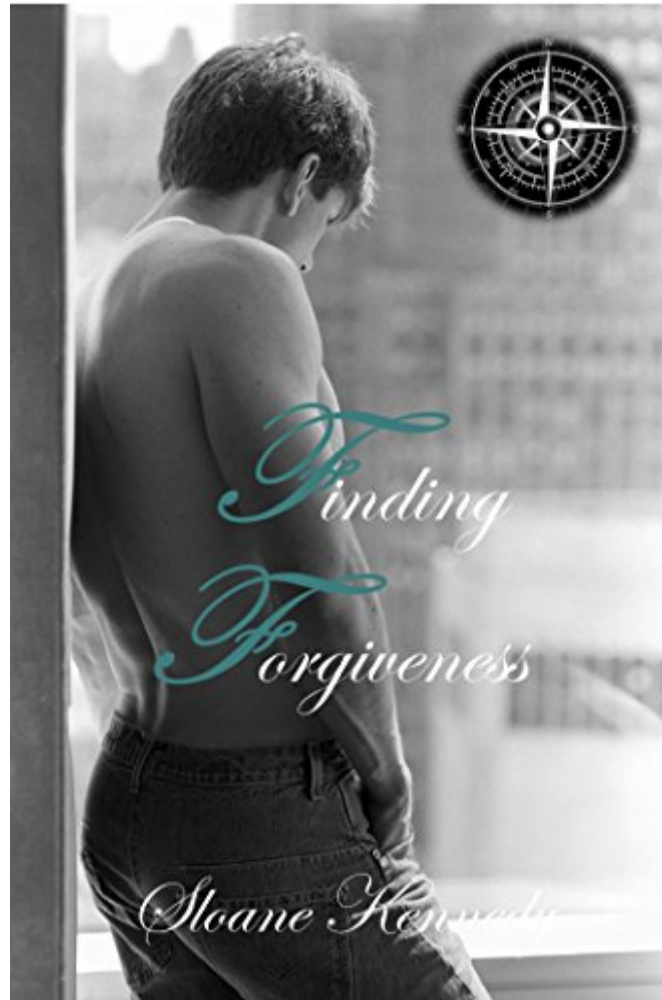

The fourth book in the Finding series can be read as a standalone, technically, but IMHO, they're best read in order, as 1) previous characters (very validly) appear in each successive tale, and bonus, we get to see them living their HEAs, 2) there's an important connection between Hunter and the leads from book 1, and between Roman and the leads from book 3, and 3) because Sloane Kennedy just keeps getting better and better with each new book. How she writes so quickly, how she does it and manages to bring something new and fresh to each book, whilst still linking them believably, is impressive. Soon-to-be 20yo Hunter turns out to be the 'baddie' from book 1, though he only appeared in name in that, but here, he's a broken character wracked with guilt and believes that he deserves to be punished for what he unthinkingly and unintentionally did. Yes, he was naive and scared, and yes, there were some very nasty consequences, but he didn't act maliciously, and there were understandable reasons for what he did. His pain and suffering, both mental and physical, were upsetting and painful to read about, which is not at all a criticism of the book, simply a warning that it doesn't pull its punches and that you'll read, feel and almost see what SK describes. The book starts with a shocker of a scene, that even as a beta reader of hers, I couldn't have envisaged, but which showed how low and in the depths of despair Hunter was, and how little love he had for himself. It saddened and shocked me, but it also brought Roman into his life. Roman, in book 3, came across as cold, closed off, unfeeling and unbending, but his icy demeanour didn't last more than 3/4 pages into this book, and he ended up being Hunter's saviour - and his salvation.
