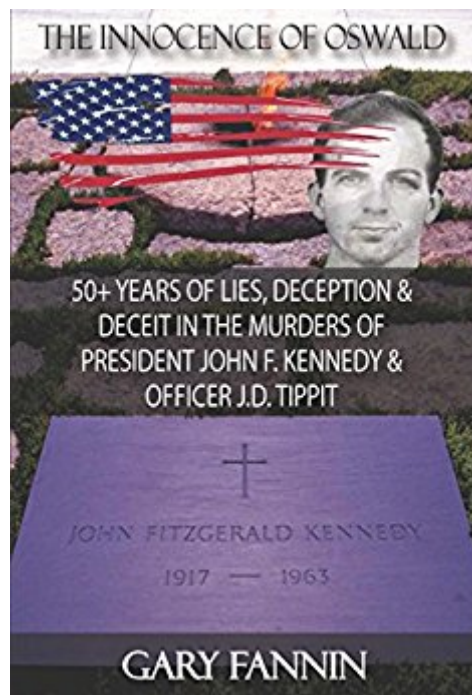

There is no GARBAGE in this book. Gary Fannin does not speculate - he provides hard concrete facts and supporting documentation.
