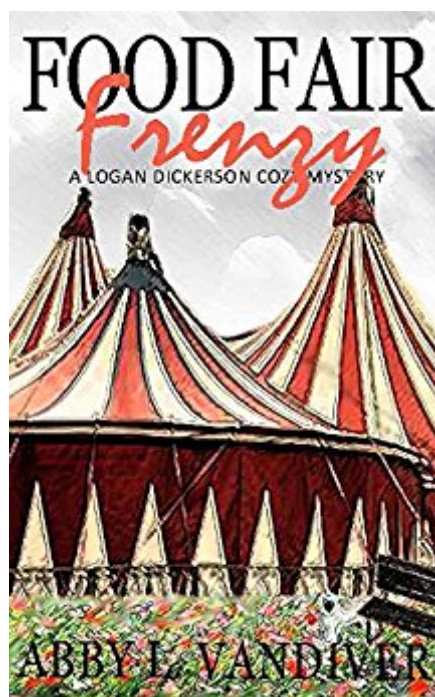

Author Abby Vandiver does it again with this charming and humorous cozy mystery. Set in Georgia at the 105th Fremont County Annual Possum Pickin' Food Fair, Miss Vivee, Logan, Mac, and all of the other characters that you have come to know and love, are knee deep in cherry pie guts as people start dropping, like flies, around them. Did the pie in question come from the "Pie to Die for" booth? Logan and Miss Vivee soon find themselves on the hunt for a murderer when Jack Wagner, wealthy land owner and pie judge, ends up dead. With a whole new cast of characters to investigate, Miss Vivee and Logan have only one clue to help them solve this mystery -- a "flowery" poem left behind by the killer. A fun and quick read with lots of colorful conversations; this one is a must.

Come along to the small town of Yasamee, a coastal town off the Savannah River by Augusta, GA, where Archaeologist Logan Dickerson has been doing some recent digging. The only thing that Logan has been digging these days is clues to find out who murdered Jack Warner, owner of Lincoln Park and co-owner of Krieger's Greenhouse with his wife Camren. Nothing could make Miss Vivee happier than being made to feel important when Sheriff Lloyd Haynes asking her assistance in solving the murder. Also enter Logan's boyfriend grandson of Miss Vivee, Bay Colquett who works for the FBI. Miss Vivee, Doc Mac and Logan begin to solve the mystery using the note of poison flowers surrounding Jack Warner's death. So come along, grab your hat, the book calls this story a combination of 'Betty White meets Angela Lansbury with Andy Griffin as the sidekick' and boy does that say it all. You also meet Renmar, owner of Maypop Bed and Breakfast daughter of Miss Vivee along with her best friend Hazel Cobb, Brie and her boyfriend Sheriff Haynes.

Logan, Miss Vivee and Mac are at it again! A murder occurs at the Annual Possum Pickin' Food Fair. The dead man is Jackson Wagner, owner of the land where the fair is being held, and he's from Old Georgia money. Miss Vivee, Logan's boyfriend's 100 year-old grandmother and a self-professed Voodoo Herbalist, is asked by police to help because the victim was killed by ingesting a botanical poison. Using a poem that the murderer left behind, Miss Vivee, Logan and Mac, Miss Vivee's boyfriend, join together to try and track down a killer. Great read! Love these folks from the Maypop Bed & Breakfast in Yasamee, Georgia! You'll love them, too!

Another mystery with plenty of suspects. Logan takes a backseat to Miss Vivienne sleuthing skills in this book. But in all fairness Logan has a lot on her mind, marriage to bay.
